04. According to the data published by the Department of Census and Statistics, the Gross Domestic Product (GDP) for the period 2018-2023 is as follows (Figure 01).

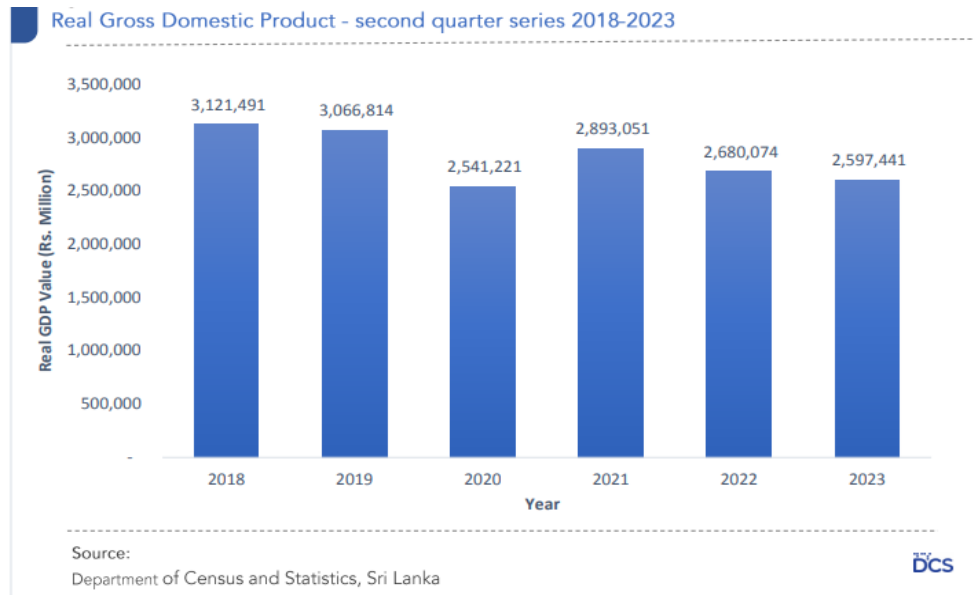

05. According to the data published by the Central Bank of Sri Lanka, the outflow of workers for foreign employment during the period 2021-2024 is as follows (Figure 02).

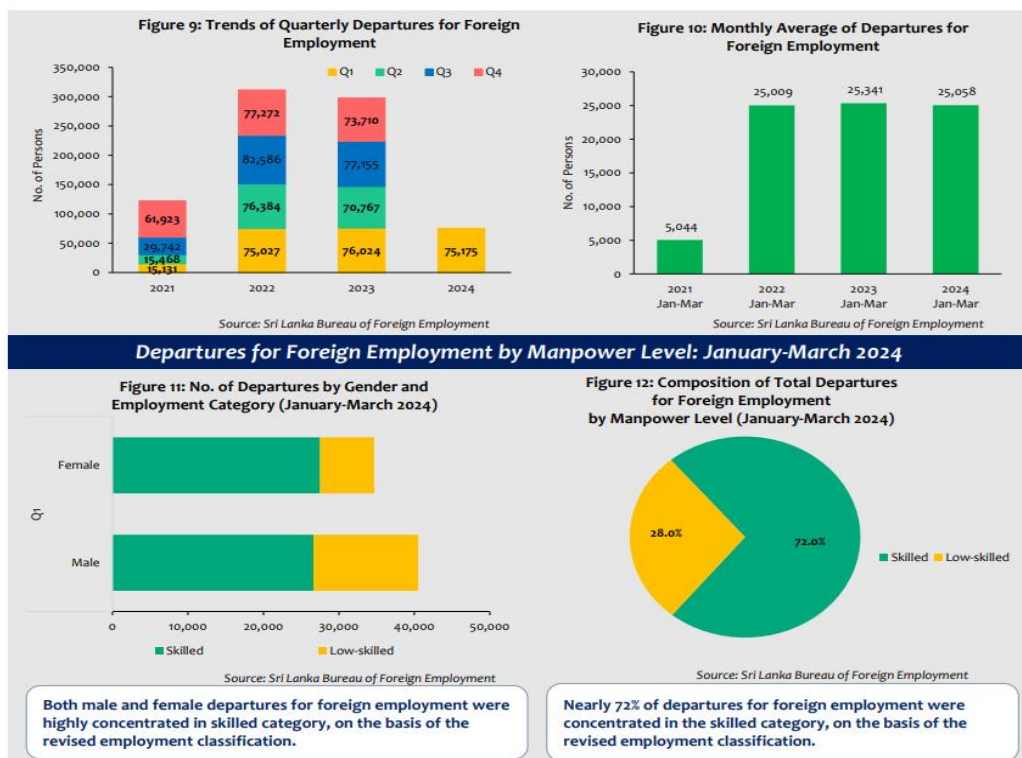
