2. It is possible to recognize a management revolution through orderly and stable changes as a trust of development administration even within the current government bureaucracy. Explain with examples as to how this revolution influences the development administration of Sri Lanka, (20 marks)
3. In the recent past, Sri Lanka Railways and the need for efficient service became a topic of discussion in various social strata. As an officer of Sri Lanka Administrative Service, analytically present as to how Department Sri Lanka Railways/ Service should be restructured and reformed. (20 marks)
4. Describe the following topics. .
 - 4.1. Digitization of Sri Lankan government services and formalizing the Development Administration process. (10 marks)
 - 4.2. Development Administration for People Centric development in Sri Lanka. (10 marks)
